**IMPORTANT TO NOTE: -Players enrolling for this tournament will abide to rules & regulations as mentioned below during the course of the tournament.**

## **INVITATION**

Eleven brothers Society has the honor to invite all players to participate in the All-Assam Open Prize Money Online Chess Tournament.

### **General Rules & Regulations**

All-Assam Open Prize Money Online Chess Tournament is an individual championship and shall be governed by the FIDE Online Chess Regulations.

### **Entry Fee**

The Entry Fee is Rs. 300 per player. Entry fee must be paid on or before 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2021.

### **Tournament System**

The tournament shall be conducted as a Swiss System competition of 7 rounds and will be played according to FIDE Regulations for Online Chess with Supervision. However, number of rounds may be changed depending upon number of players.

### **Fair Play Rules**

Players may play only on laptop or desktop. Players should log into Zoom with their starting rank number and name. The Zoom Arbiters shall virtually inspect the Setup of Playing Devices and Zoom Set up of players before the start of each game. Only players are allowed access to his / her playing area.

Each player shall be monitored by front videocam. Only players with approved cameras and device set up will be allowed to play. The camera should show clear view of the player. **If required, Arbiters may intimate players to install side angle camera any time in the course of championship also and players are obliged to follow the same.**

The fair play measures should be applied in accordance with the FIDE Anti-Cheating Regulations and FIDE Anti-Cheating Protection Measures. Players shall be monitored by Tornelo Live Fair Play Reports.

Unless authorized by the arbiter, it is forbidden for anybody to use a mobile phone or other kind of communication or electronic device in the playing venue, or any contiguous area designated by the Zoom Arbiters.

The Zoom Arbiters should see that each player is connected to Zoom. Front Audio in Zoom should always be open during live games. It is not allowed for players to use headphones or virtual Zoom background. Playing venue should be well lit. There should be no external noise.

All participants shall comply and co-operate with the Fair Play rules. Players may be removed from the Championship at any time on final decision of the Chief Arbiter based on fair play rules.

All the players agree that they have no right to appeal the aforementioned actions either through arbitration, consultation or in a court of law within any jurisdiction. Participants have no right to appeal for pairings made during the Championship.

By registering in the Championship, players will not have the right to claim any financial compensation or redress related to the Championship.

For the success of the event the Organizer has the right to change the schedule with due notice, update the regulations or decide for any matter that is not mentioned in the current regulations.

### **Video Conferencing System (Zoom) Arbiters**

No other website, application or software can be open on the playing device except Tornelo and Zoom.

Players should share their desktop screen in Zoom and make Task Manager "Always on top". The images of the video conferencing platform may be recorded by the organizer.

### **Disconnections**

It is the player's responsibility to be connected to the zoom as well as playing platform. This includes providing a stable internet connection and a working playing device. During a disconnection both players must not leave their places without the permission of the Arbiter.

An internet disconnection **from ZOOM** for a duration of 5 minutes from zoom or more will be declared loss.

### **Communication:**

- • Zoom Chat • Arbiters chat on tornelo (Arbiters call) a. Players shall not be permitted to contact anyone during the course of play.
- b. Players shall have a direct line of communication to their assigned arbiter during the course of play. This shall be done via the Zoom chat, with the Arbiter clearly identified by "Arbiter" in their Zoom name
- c. Players shall notify the Arbiter immediately in the event they are facing a technical issue.

If they are unable to contact the arbiter via Zoom due to connectivity issues, they must attempt to reconnect during the round but may not contact via other methods.

**Penalties:** All the penalties will be in accordance with FIDE Online Chess regulations for online tournaments with supervision (section III a). Any serious offence may result in disqualification from the whole tournament, at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.

**Additional Actions:** In addition, any violations outlined in this section may be subject to additional fair play screening which may result in the player's clock running while the screening is taking place.

**Operating System & Web browser:** Players shall only use MICROSOFT WINDOWS OS to play this championship. Any other operating systems (Mac/Linux etc) are not allowed as a playing device. Google Chrome web browser is highly recommended by the playing platform. Only tabs open in the web browser are for the platform being used i.e. Tornelo. Players must use a mouse or touch pad to make the moves and touch screen method for moving the piece is not allowed.

**Internet connection:** Internet connectivity is the player's responsibility. Please ensure you have a reliable connection which you trust.

**Webcam:** A functioning webcam is mandatory so that arbiters can comfortably see you and your surroundings. Players must be able to scan their playing area using their webcam.

**Lighting:** Adequate and even lighting is required, including on the players' faces. Natural light can be sufficient but artificial lighting is highly recommended for consistency. Please ensure that you and your surroundings will be visible on camera at all times.

**Microphone / Speakers:** A working microphone & speakers are mandatory. You must be able to hear arbiters. Please make sure speakers are turned on before the start of competition so arbiters can communicate with you. The arbiter may request that you turn up your microphone in order to observe noise originating from your call. Players must comply with this request.

**Headphones:** During play, headphones will not be permitted during the course of play. You may use them before or after the games.

**Time Control:**

Time control is Rapid Play - Each player shall have 15 minutes for the game with the addition of 5 seconds per move starting from the first move. The clocks of all games shall be started by the Chief Arbiter.

**Pairings:**

Swiss pairings shall be made on Javafo (Tornelo/Swiss Manger).

**Individual Tie-break System**

The final ranking order of the players is determined by the number of points scored. If at the end of the tournament two or more players are tied for the first place or for any prize, the tie shall be broken in accordance with the following: -

1. Buchholz Cut 1
2. Buchholz
3. Sonneborn-Berger
4. Direct encounter
5. The greater number of wins including forfeits
6. Number of wins with Black pieces

One player will be eligible for one prize only and players winning prizes in age group categories are required to produce valid date of birth certificate
